Comprehensive plans are a community's opportunity to evaluate various facets of their municipality—jobs, housing, transportation, environment, etc.—and identify adjustments needed to ensure the community remains a desirable place to live and work over the decades to come.

East Stroudsburg's Comprehensive Plan Update will result in realistic, implementable action plans for 10 priority issues, determined in part by community and business leaders and residents. The planning process will engage these stakeholders to discuss solution strategies, performance measures, implementation aspects (leadership, coordination, timing, funding) of each issue, and management tools to measure plan progress.
