April 3, 2018 Minutes

A motion was made by Mr. Cross and seconded by Mr. Molin, to approve the April 3, 2018, Council Meeting minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Public Hearing

Conditional Use Hearing, East Stroudsburg University, Information Commons: A motion was made by Mr. Flory and seconded by Mr. Reese to reconviene the conditional use hearing at 5:31 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.

The public hearing was conducted and the court stenographer recorded the notes from the hearing.

A motion was made by Mr. Cross and seconded by Mr. Flory to close the public hearing at 5:50 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Molin and seconded by Mr. Reese to go into Executive Session at 5:51 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Cross and seconded by Mr. Reese to reconvene the meeting at 6:01 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Reese and seconded by Mr. Molin to approve the East Stroudsburg University Information Commons Conditional Use with conditions as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

East Stroudsburg University Information Commons Revised Preliminary and Final Land Development Application

The Land Development Plan has been submitted with all details and reviewed. Mr. Peters, of ESU, asked if there were any questions for their engineers. Mr. Molin asked when demolition is scheduled. The engineers responded that once the project is out for bid, it would be about two months before demolition. A contractor needs to be picked, they need to remove and re-route the fire alarms in the building to keep campus safe, and a bunker needs to be built for fire alarms. Mr. Oiler mentioned that Normal and South Green Streets are Borough streets; Ken Long stated they are still figuring out the ownership of those streets. Mr. Long also noted that when the bid goes out for this project, the route will be indicated for contractors and if the Borough notices any violations to the outlined route, the Borough Manager should contact Mr. Long immediately.

Mr. Bond prepared Resolution 7-2018 Approval of East Stroudsburg University Information Commons Land Development Application. Mr. Prevoznik advised Exhibit A, the 38 page document of legal conclusions, should be signed and attached to the resolution.

A motion was made by Mr. Molin and seconded by Mr. Flory to execute the decision and adjudication of the East Stroudsburg University Information Commons Land Development Application The motion was carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Reese and seconded by Mr. Flory to approve the request for modification from Section 140-9 and Section 140-35 to allow the plan be considered as a preliminary/final land development plan. The motion carried unanimously.

The motion carried unanimously.
