



COVID 19 Municipal Facilities Access Policy

The Borough of East Stroudsburg in response to the Corona Virus the Borough is instituting following Policy regarding Municipal Facilities Access.

This policy is a temporary policy which can be modified at any time, it is contemplated that this will be in effect for eight (8) weeks and can be reviewed, lengthened and shortened at any time by information received.

This policy is to help ensure that the Borough of East Stroudsburg will be able to provides all services to the citizens of the Borough without disruption while keeping the employees and residents of the Borough safe.

1. All essential facilities (Waste Water Treatment Plant, Water Treatment Plant, Borough Annex and the Maintenance Facility) will be closed to all non-employees except State and Federal Employees that are required to have access.
2. The Municipal Building will be closed to public. All members of the Public are encouraged to conduct all business via electronic means (online Bill Pay) and to utilize the payment drop-off box located at the Municipal Building and regular mail for paying bills and tickets.
3. The Zoning Hearing Board, Planning Commission, and Committee meetings are canceled exclusive of the Stroud Area Regional Police Commission, Stroud Regional Open Space and Recreation Commission and the Monroe County Control Center Board of Directors until Borough Council approves a date for them to reconvene.

4. All Inspections conducted by Borough Personnel are postponed until Borough Council sets a date for them to reconvene.
5. The Recycling Center shall be on the following schedule: The yard will be closed for drop off of recyclable materials. The weekly recyclable curbside pickup shall remain unchanged.
6. The Terra Greens Golf Course shall be closed until further notice.
