A motion was made by Mr. Cross and seconded by Ms. Panepinto to postpone the Rededication of Veterans Park to Wednesday, November 11 at 1:00 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ms. Wolbert and seconded by Mr. Molin to ratify the order for Temporary Emergency Medical Facilities. The motion carried unanimously.
