**Hometown Heroes Banner Program**

The Benevolent Protective Order of Elks 319, East Stroudsburg, has been asked by the East Stroudsburg Borough to take over the Hometown Heroes Banner Program, a tribute to military veterans who have served honorably, or are currently serving, in a military branch. Each banner honors a specific veteran with their picture, service branch, and years served (or conflict served, if preferred). Elks 319 is proud to take on this project.

Applications for the Hometown Heroes Banners are being accepted through **February 15, 2023**. A \$220 fee is required with each banner application. Your fee includes production of the banner, shipping, and installation costs. If any funds are remaining after the aforementioned costs are paid, the excess will be added to beautify the East Stroudsburg Veterans Park. The banners will hang for a three-year period, at which time the Banner Committee will assess the condition of each banner. You can choose to let the banner hang for an extended period of time if the banner is in good condition. If your banner is tattered, you will have the option to pay a replacement fee, including labor costs, in order to keep the banner hanging. Otherwise, the banner will be taken down and it will be yours to keep.

Banners are expected to be hung in time for Memorial Day 2023. Locations of the banners will be near Veterans Park and will continue through town, depending on the response.

Please submit the application and payment no later than **February 15, 2023**. Make sure to print the information clearly on the application and double check for accuracy as this will serve as the final information for the product.
